SCHEDULE:

- **Finger Play:** Finger painting, exploring different mediums
- **Circle Time:** Daily schedule, discuss theme, social interaction, sitting and attending
- **Move and Groove:** Obstacle courses, passing activities, ball skills, balance, coordination, motor planning, cooperative play
- **Snack:** Self-help skills and social interaction
- **Arts and Crafts:** Drawing, cutting, coloring, stringing, stickers
- **Lunch**

- Demonstrate age-appropriate sports skills (kicking, throwing, catching)
- Engage in cooperative and turn-taking activities with peers
- Demonstrate age-appropriate coloring and cutting skills
- Sequence and complete art projects
- Identify "Zone" and activities to help stay in the "Green Zone"
- Generate ideas for activities and play safely with peers during unstructured play
